

The first prize winner of the CIONET European Research Paper of the Year is "Information Technology and Firm Profitability: Mechanisms and Empirical Evidence" by Sunil Mithas (University of Maryland), Ali Tafti (University of Illinois), Indranil Bardhan (University of Texas), and Jie Mein Goh (IE Business School). The paper appeared in the March 2012 (36:1) issue of *MIS Quarterly*.
